Latest Project Progress Update: Sufficient land has been purchased

IM's Patna congregation is an established and growing church located near the ministry headquarters in Bihar. The goal of our Patna City Church is to reach and engage with the high-caste and high-class communities in Patna City, which are among the least reached groups by any missions.

In North India, about 95% of believers belong to lower castes and classes, perpetuating the common belief that all Christians are of lower castes. People belonging to lower caste communities often have an inferiority complex due to historical suppression by upper caste communities. As a result, North India needs a breakthrough.

Unlike HIM's other churches, our proposed Patna City church will focus more on high-class and high-caste communities in the city. We anticipate welcoming government officials, diplomats, professionals, businessmen, and people from all walks of life to the capital city of Bihar. To enhance the church experience, we plan to include a parking area, cafeteria, and recreation hall.

This church will be a pioneering effort in our

ministry and likely the first of its kind in the entire state of Bihar. As a model church, it will set an example for other ministries to follow. The proposed location of the church is close to the city airport and the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), one of the top medical colleges in India. Thousands of employees from various states work at the institute, making it an ideal location for reaching out to a diverse community.

- THE GOAL Reach both the high caste & high class people The goal is to reach the high caste and high class community of Patna city who are currently unreached.
- **REASON** About 90% of North Indian converts belong to lower castes and lower classes, creating a common misconception among people of other faiths that all Christians are from lower castes. This has resulted in Christians being degraded based on caste consciousness. The Patna City Church Project aims to break this trend by reaching out to high-class and upper-caste communities, including professionals, diplomats, officers, and intellectuals. This breakthrough will create a more inclusive and harmonious society, where people of all castes and backgrounds can worship and serve God together.





WHY PATNA CHURCH NEEDS PROFESSIONALS AND HIGH-CASTE INDIVIDUALS?

Breaking Stereotypes and Building a Stronger Community

The Patna church will need individuals who hold positions of influence and have access to resources, such as high caste, high class people, officers, professionals, and diplomats - not because of their caste or social status. but because of their ability to bring about positive change in the community! These individuals can use their education and resources to support the church's mission of serving the community and spreading the message of Christ. It is important to note that the church believes in the equality of all people and that Christians come from all castes and backgrounds. However, having individuals in positions of influence can help to amplify the impact of the church's work and bring about positive change in the entire Patna city community.

Educated and Influential People Needed to Protect Patna Church Community

The Patna church recognizes the growing need for educated and influential people in the community, especially in the face of increasing attacks on Christians and their places of worship in North India. These attacks, which have become a daily occurrence, are typically initiated by upper-caste people on native low-caste believers, while there has not been a single reported attack on native upper-caste believers. The situation is the same for educated low-caste believers. It is clear that education plays a significant role in protecting the community from such attacks, and therefore, the church emphasizes the need for highly educated and influential individuals to join the community. By bringing in more educated and influential people, the church hopes to strengthen their position and protect the entire community, regardless of caste or social status, for the greater good of all.

Breaking Barriers of Caste-Based Discrimination: A Vision of the Patna City Church Project

The Patna City Church Project is a crucial step towards combating the negative effects of the Indian Caste System. Bihar, being one of the most backward Indian states, has unfortunately ingrained casteism into the identities of its people more than any other state. This discrimination

regardless of their social status. By promoting the message of unity and equality, the project hopes to dispel the misconceptions surrounding Christianity and create a more harmonious society.


- Patna City Church aims to become self-sufficient and support other churches in the future.

- The church will be a model for other North Indian city churches in sharing its vision and mission.




LOCATION OF OUR CHURCH AND PROPOSED PATNA METRO RAILWAY ROUTE


